Ballots can be returned via mail or to the Noarlunga Council Office

If you have not received your ballot material by Thursday 20 October you can contact the South Australian Electoral Commission via their website www.ecsa.sa.gov.au.

You can apply for replacement voting material until at 5 pm on Thursday 3 November.

Each eligible voter will receive;
 Ballot papers for the election of Mayor, a separate ballot paper for the election of two ward councillors and a candidate profile brochure.








To make a formal vote, you must number **at least** as many boxes as there are vacancies, in the order of your choice. ('1' for Mayor & '1' & '2' for Ward Councillors).

Fleurieu Connections Update

Night work – Main South Road between Malpas and Port Roads

As part of the Main South Road Duplication project, night works will be undertaken to remove barriers and place temporary asphalt along Main South Road between Malpas Road and Port Road. Motorists can expect changes to traffic conditions.

Traffic will move to the outer lanes (overtaking lanes) and be a single lane in both directions. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place. These works will have no changes to current cyclist and pedestrian access.

Signage will be in place to help guide you through the area. Please allow extra time when planning your journey. Please observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Vale Stan Beck

23rd November 1929 – 1st August 2022

We gathered to farewell Dad on Tuesday 9th August at the beautiful little Sellicks Beach Graveyard on a sublime winter's afternoon.

The alpacas and lambs gambolled in the adjacent paddock, the almond blossoms nodded pinkly and the sun glinted on the distant sea.

Stan was a quiet achiever; he was dedicated to family and to the local community, demonstrating resilience and commitment through membership of various groups and organisations.

When the unspoilt landscape of Sellicks Beach was threatened by inappropriate development in 1988, Stan was involved in the local movement to save the coastal area. "Sellicks Marina? a pain in the Groyne" was the catchphrase and the group successfully preserved the beach.

Stan was treasurer of the Aldinga Bay Residents Association for many years working closely with other stalwarts in the area to improve and protect environmental, social and cultural values in the district.

He was also treasurer of Opus Performing Arts Board and joined the Tribe FM Community Radio station, based in Willunga, when it first started, sitting on the first Board. When the Bendigo Bank started its branch in Aldinga, he was a founding Director.

Dad has been a naval officer, carpenter, electrical engineer, swimming pool builder, vegetable garden tender, dog lover, security guard, Local Councillor,

Neighbourhood Watch participant, library volunteer, vintage car enthusiast, billiards player, wine maker, fix it man, father, ... and Santa! People who live in Sellicks Beach would remember many Christmases enlivened by his good cheer around the streets of the neighbourhood.

After living in Sellicks Beach for 42 years the pull of the landscape and attachment to his Pebble House home was very strong. Strong enough to let him draw his final breath at home gazing at the garden and find a final resting place up on Sellicks Hill under the rustling gum trees.

Rest in peace.

Heritage Exhibition

The Art of the Willunga District's Built Heritage exhibition is currently on at the Onkaparinga Gallery at the Onkaparinga Arts Centre at Port Noarlunga from 16 September to 24 October 2022.

The opening night on 16 September attracted 150 people who enjoyed the Kay Brothers wines (courtesy of Kay Brothers winery) and finger food. The exhibition aims to inspire, interest and educate visitors about the long, and continuing, tradition of artistic representations of heritage buildings, historic sites and past events in the Willunga District. A full colour catalogue (only \$10) is available at the venue and provides details of the artists and the places that they have painted.

This exhibition heralds a fresh, new perspective, which focuses on the intersection of art and heritage. It underscores the importance of an emotional, visceral sense of identity that gives meaning to our community. Built heritage art can provide insights into memories of the past, and how the appearance of buildings, ruins and jetties have changed over time. Built heritage art changes the discourse from Art as Heritage to Art depicting Heritage. Our heritage provides a perspective on who we are and what we value. It communicates a richer and more aesthetic expression about how our community has developed.

The exhibition was curated by a team of volunteers from the National Trust of South Australia (Willunga Branch), with funding and support from the Onkaparinga Arts Centre (City of Onkaparinga), the History Trust of South Australia (SA Government), Kay Brothers Winery and donors. It features original artworks including oil paintings, watercolour paintings and drawings of such aspects of the built and historic environment in the Willunga District including Willunga, Aldinga, Port Willunga, McLaren Vale and other locations. The exhibition includes the work of both past and living artists such as Anton Riebe, Valerie Wright, Bill Walls, Jane Price, Kenneth Jack, Peg Berry, Brian Seidel, Chris Olsen, Bill Walls, Lesley Redgate, G.F. Gregory junior, Barbara Storer, Horace Trenerry, Lynn Chamberlain, Geoff Wilson, Chris Olsen, Hugo Shaw and others.

At a Death Cafe people, often strangers, gather to eat cake, drink tea and discuss death.

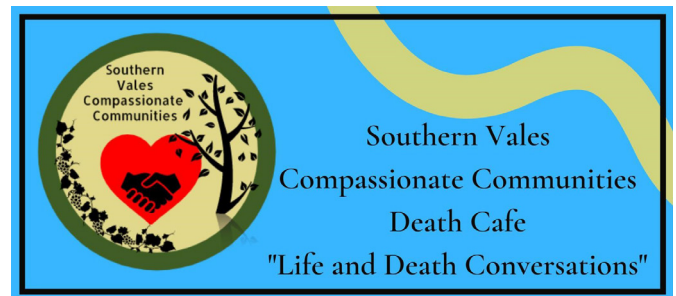
Our objective is 'to increase awareness of death with a view to helping people make the most of their (finite) lives'.

This month at the 2022 SA Environment Awards our region was represented by finalists in two awards. Local ecologist and ABRA Committee Member Matt Farrell, was one of 3 finalists for the Jill Hopman Award for Environmental Protection, and Biodiversity McLaren Vale (BMV) was a Finalist in the Working Together Award.



Matt (pictured above) was nominated for his advocacy work with the Sellicks Woodlands and Wetlands Action Network (SWWAN) for regenerating the environment and reversing biodiversity loss as priorities in the long-term plans for Adelaide. BMV were nominated for their work to preserve and regenerate biodiversity across the region.

The inspiring headline speech was delivered by Peter Malinouskas and Deputy Premier Dr Susan Close was also in attendance. Five Lifetime Achiever Awards were given to Dr Mike Bossley AM, Margaret Lee, Major 'Moogy' Sumner AM, Dr Richard Willing OAM and Betty Westwood OAM, and Sophie Thomson won the Green Adelaide Pelzer Award.
